Saturday, 22nd	10.15am – 1.30pm	Evzones march from Intercontinental Hotel along North Terrace to War Memorial: Arrival Ceremony and Changing of the Guard
	5.30– 7.30pm	Evzones march from St George College to St George Church for an Official Vespers Service at 6.30pm followed by a return march to St George College, 75 Rose Street, Mile End
Sunday 23rd	10am	Evzones march from St George College along Rose Street to St George Church
	10.30 – 11.30am	Official liturgy at St George Church for Anzac Day and St George's Day, followed by the Evzones march back to St George College to attend the St George's Paniyiri (fete).
	12 noon – 8pm	Paniyiri with 11 members of the party from Greece in attendance, food, live music and entertainment.
